



MINIFLIPPER

This little guide explains how to integrate the miniflipper.

After activating the iBrochure and downloading the ZIPfile (iPublish.zip) you need to extract the ZIPfile.

After extraction you will have a folder called “**ib**”
In this folder the folder “**mini**” and the file “**mini.html**” are important.

There are 2 possibilities for implementation:

1. By using a iFrame:

Create a iFrame with your preferred size on the webpage you want to show your miniflipper. The page which needs to links inside the iFrame is mini.html. You need to delete the sentence “ how to install the mini” on that page.

2. By implementing the flashfile(swf):

Open the webpage where you want to implement your miniflipper and copy the following code where you want to show the miniflipper (in the sourcecode):

Important!

The “mini” folder needs to be on the same level as the webpage where you want to implement the miniflipper.

Changing the link to your iBrochure:

Once the miniflipper you want to link the miniflipper to the iBrochure. This can be done by opening the “**link.xml**” file inside the “**mini**” folder.

Open the “link.xml” with a regular texteditor and change the link to where the iBrochure is hosted:
